Hospitality House

The Hospitality House in Parma, Ohio, was founded in 1989 under the guidance of the Very Rev. Archpriest Dennis Hrubiak and the late Father Emil Masich.

The outreach provides a hot meal once a week, on Tuesdays, to anyone who walks through the door, regardless of race, creed or ethnicity. In addition, guests receive a brown-bag breakfast for the next day plus a takeout bag of food for another meal.

The Hospitality House also hosts a number of young people (Scouting groups and high school students) who perform volunteer service hours. Thus, St. Mary Hospitality House accomplishes a twofold goal: it provides Eastern Christian hospitality, solidarity and service to those who come through the doors; and it provides a concrete means of living out the Gospel call to become beatitude people.
